Community Sports Leader Award in Archery

Thank you for your enquiry about the above award. It is the minimum level of qualification for people who would like to be involved in introducing people to Archery. It involves a 4 ½ day course, with an oral and practical assessment at the end (½ day).

The course covers:

Learning to shoot using different shooting techniques and learning basic beginners style.
Teaching methods, safety and shooting improvement.
Equipment maintenance, other forms of archery.
Practice and revision, followed by assessment (practical and oral).

Prior registration with the Grand National Archery Society will ensure that each candidate receives an Information Pack. During the course candidates may also receive some handouts, which will be useful and informative.

The fee for individual booking for the course is £220 this includes £70 for GNAS registration and Leader Information Pack.(This price is subject to change without notice) The certificate awarded to successful candidates lasts for 3 years, after which it can be renewed on payment of a renewal fee, which is currently set at £30, and production of evidence that the holder is still involved in introducing people to Archery.
